## From Your Pastor

Dear Grace Family and Friends,

I was greatly blessed to spend last week in Ukraine with our Mission team. You were well represented and many people heard The Good News of The Gospel for the first time. Trips like this change you forever. Few things are as humbling as the recognition of just how richly blessed Americans are. The average household income in Odessa, Ukraine is \$195.00 per month. Few Ukrainians own automobiles. Those who do drive very little because the price of gasoline is so expensive. It was just under \$2.00 per liter, or about \$7.00 per gallon! The majority have no prospect of ever owning their own home. Most will struggle financially their whole lives. Why do they stay? It's home, and the cost to move to another country is prohibitive. So they persevere and hope for the best. But that takes a toll. Having grown numb to their circumstances, depression becomes a very prevalent reality. What a thrill it was to tell them of the joy that comes from knowing Jesus Christ. He died for their sins too, you know. They need simply confess their sins to Him and receive His forgiveness by childlike faith and they will be saved as surely as we are. Yet how will they know of that option? The Orthodox Church isn't going to tell them. That was the official "Church" of the Soviet Union and they made sure The Gospel was never preached. I'm thankful for the opportunity to fill that void, especially with the children. I hope you'll plan to be here this evening to hear more about the trip from our Team members. But whether or not you plan to attend, please be in prayer for the people we encountered last week. Pray that seeds planted would produce a glorious harvest for the cause of Christ. I love you and am honored to be your Pastor. God bless you!
