2Corinthians 4:8-9 We are hard pressed on every side, yet not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed-

I. DIVINE INSPIRATION

- James 5:13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray.
 - **suffering**: experiencing hardship; enduring affliction; troubled; suffering
- Matthew 28:20b "Surely I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
- James 5:14 Is any among you sick?
 - **sick**: asthen-eh'-o to be feeble; to be weak; to be diseased; not healthy; sick.
- <u>James 5:14b</u> Let him call for the elders of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of The Lord.

II. DEFINITIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- John 17:3 And this is everlasting life, that they may know You, the one true God, and Jesus Christ whom You sent.
 - **know**: ginosko be aware; have knowledge of; perceive; be sure of; understand
- <u>Hebrews 11:6</u> But without faith it is impossible to please God, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He rewards those who diligently seek Him.
 - o pistis: complete persuasion; reliance upon; constancy in; assurance; belief; faith
- <u>Isaiah 53:5</u> But He was wounded for our transgressions, bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.
 - healed: raw-faw' to mend; to cure; to thoroughly make whole
- <u>2Timothy 4:20</u> Erastus stayed in Corinth, but Trophimus I left in Miletus sick.
- <u>1Timothy 5:23</u> No longer drink only water but use a little wine for your stomach's sake and your frequent infirmities.
- James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed.
 healed: ee-ah'-omy to cure a disease; to heal; to make whole

FAITH:

- James 5:16b The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
- <u>Matthew 9:22</u> But Jesus said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well." And the woman was made well from that hour.
- <u>Mark 10:52</u> Jesus said, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road.
- Luke 17:19 Jesus said to him, "Rise & go; your faith has made you well."
- James 1:7 Let not that man suppose he'll receive anything from The Lord
