Introduction

• I Corinthians 15:10 But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

<u>II Corinthians 8:9</u> For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich

- God's Plan
- Romans 3:21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets

God's plan is:

- A) Precise "Now"
- B) Predicated "Witnessed"

2. God's Provision

• Romans 3:22-23 ven the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all^[3] who believe. For there is no difference; ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

Provided the human race with:

- A) An Intercessor "Through"
- <u>I Timothy 2:5</u> For *there is* one God and one Mediator between God and men, *the* Man Christ Jesus
- I John 2:1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
- B) An Invitation "To all"
- Acts 10:34 Then Peter opened *his* mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality.
- Romans 10:10-13 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. ¹³ For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."
- C) An Indictment "All"

3. God's Payment

• Romans 3: 24-25b being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed

His Payment paid for my:

- A) Freedom "Justified"
- John 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.
- **B)** Forgiveness "Grace"
- Acts 10:43 To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins."
- C) Future "In Jesus"
- 4. God's Patience
- Romans 3:25c-26 whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, ²⁶ to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Reveals His:

- A) Restraint "Forbearance"
- **B)** Righteousness "R-ness"
