THE LAW OF THE HARVEST
Galatians 6:7-8

- **Proverbs 21:17** He who loves pleasure will be a poor man; he who loves wine and oil will not be rich.

I. A DIVINE PRINCIPLE

- **Galatians 6:7** Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.
- **Proverbs 18:24** A man who would have friends must himself be friendly,...
- **Luke 6:37** Forgive, and you will be forgiven.
- **Luke 6:38** Give and it will be given to you, pressed down, shaken together and running over will be given to you.
- **Mark 4:20** These are those sown on good soil; who hear word, accept it & bear fruit: some 30, some 60 and some 100 fold
- **Galatians 6:9** Let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.
 - **due: idi-os'** - that which pertains to self; my own
 - **season: kahee-ros'** - time, season; in proper sequence
- **Mark 10:28-30** Then Peter began to say to Him, "See, we have left all and followed You." So Jesus answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions—and in the age to come, eternal life.

II. A DEFENSIVE POSTURE

A. DON'T BE DECEIVED

- **Galatians 6:7** Do not be deceived...
 - **deceived:** plan-ah'o - to cause to roam from truth, virtue or safety; to go astray; to be out of the way; to be deceived
- **1 Timothy 4:1** Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

B. DON'T GROW WEARY IN WELL DOING

- **Ephesians 2:10** We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
