

How to Join Grace Baptist Church

One of the decisions you may wish to make is to become a member of Grace Baptist Church. You may do so by telling the Pastor or Staff Member one of the following:

- I have accepted Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and desire New Testament baptism.
- I have previously received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. The Church I joined did not practice New Testament baptism, so I want to be baptized and join Grace Baptist Church.
- I am a member of another Baptist Church and want to join Grace Baptist on a promise letter from that Church.
- I have previously received Christ and was baptized into a Church by New Testament baptism, however, the record of my Church membership is unavailable, or I have been a member of another denomination and wish to return to a Baptist Church.

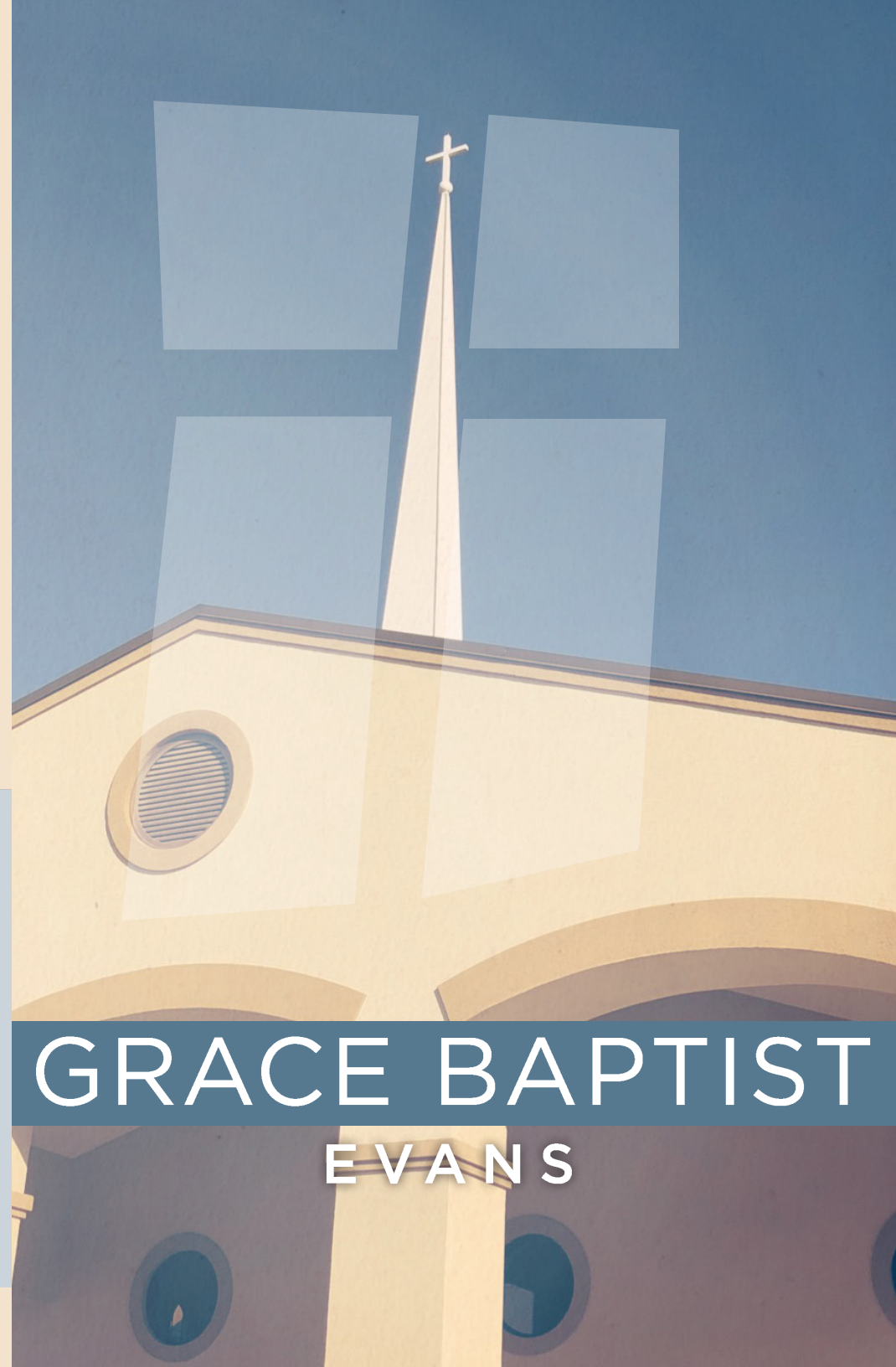

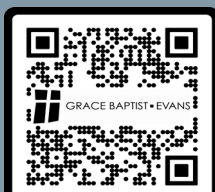

But when they aren't functioning well we realize just how valuable they are and how blessed we are that God gave us hands instead of paws. That's a good thing for sure. So next time you're in a bad mood or feel depressed, stop and ask yourself what good is coming from your "depressing circumstance?" Then give God thanks for it. You'll be glad you did!
